- Sheltered bay




- Easy to get to from Victoria and Duncan

- Muddy beach!
















- Easy to get to from Nanaimo

Halfmoon Bay (Coopers Green)


- Easy access from Sechelt

- Go when tide is out good sea life


Secret Cove

Can extend your paddle to the Thormanby Islands from either of these











Granite Bay (Quadra)


- Northern side of Quadra

- A number of options to paddle


Rebecca Spit (Quadra)

- Beautiful shoreline paddle round from the bay


Be aware of the ferries coming to and from Heriot Bay (in Drew Harbour)
























































- Just 20 minutes from Port Hardy

- Visit the museum in the old air hanger!


